Predictable Crown and Bridge Impressions and Simplified Temporization

Simplification with predictability in crown and bridge seems hard to achieve unless you have materials and techniques that work in synchronicity. This program will present systems of impressioning and temporization that lead to increased productivity and time savings with less clinical variability. These systems will facilitate the insertion of crown and bridge restorations and veneers with minimal time spent. Also discussed will be tissue management and how various hemostatic agents affect polyvinyl siloxanes materials and reduce subsequent bonding strength. Simple matrix formation for temporaries that take less than one minute will be presented.

What you will learn:

Impressions: how matched systems increase your predictability for fit.

Cords: is there a difference?

Hemostatic agents: you do not always have to use the strongest available as there is a price to pay.

Temporary Materials: there is a fast easy solution to temporary matrices. Reduction guides: how you keep track of your reduction for difficult cases.

Bite registrations: why do they now cause such a large problem for laboratories to mount cases adequately.
